

## **Visiting Our Site**

Our plant at Sefton in Canterbury, NZ, regards the health and safety of our staff and visitors as the number one priority. With this in mind, if visiting our site, you must comply with stringent health and safety requirements. Failure to comply will result in your removal from site. Please ensure you read and understand the site safety induction rules before visiting Daiken NZ, a copy is available from the contact page on our website.

## How to get to Daiken NZ, Ashley/Sefton, Canterbury

Our site is located at **166 Upper Sefton Road, Ashley RD7, Rangiora 7477**. If you're using a GPS to navigate, please use either;

- 1. 101 Beatties Road, Rangiora
- 2. 166 Upper Sefton Road, Rangiora
- From Christchurch, follow SH1 North. Take the last exit on the motorway toward Rangiora (SH71).
- Drive through Rangiora, over the Ashley River Bridge following the signs to Ashley/Loburn.
- Turn right into Fawcett's Road, continue past the Ashley School. You are now on Upper Sefton Road. Continue on towards Sefton.
- You may now see plumes of steam or the twin stacks of the factory.
- Turn right into Beattie's Road, then right again into the main gate.
- Entry is via the security barrier arm. There is an intercom which connects directly to reception (or control room after hours) to gain access. Press the button on the intercom to connect to a staff member.
- The site speed limit from the main gate is 10kph.
- Park your vehicle in the car park immediately on your left behind the mesh fence. There are four visitors' parks at the front.
- Exit on foot by the block bike shed. Use the pedestrian crossing and follow the footpath to the next pedestrian crossing which will bring you to reception.



- Follow the orange line and DO NOT JAYWALK this
  is for your safety.
- If travel to the site is by taxi, use the intercom at the barrier to call reception and then proceed to the administration building. The taxi must observe the 10kph speed limit and have hazard lights flashing.
- If entering the site from the road on foot please use the Pedestrian entrance gate in the fence to the right of the main gate and follow the path to reception.
- On entry to reception, please sign in to the site induction booklet in the main foyer.
